

## **Diane Walenda -- Watercolor supply list**

Watercolors---Tube watercolors are best. Bring what you have.

Buy what you can afford.

I suggest these colors:

Reds: Alizarin red

Greens: Sap green or Hookers green

Yellows: lemon yellow , or Aurelian yellow

Blues: Ultramarine, indigo, cobalt

~~~You will not need all of these, but 1 of each for sure~~~~

- Plastic palette, preferably with a lid
- Water container --1 pint to 1 quart size
- BRUSHES--Watercolor sizes #6 and 8 **rounds**  
1inch and and 2inch **flat**
- Watercolor Paper **Arches 1 sheet 22 x 30in**  
**140# cold press** These may be available in the  
art room for \$7/sheet. **You will get 4 paintings**  
**from 1 sheet in this class**
- Watercolor support board --½ inch thick foam core (available  
to **borrow** in art room)
- Kleenex tissues, paper towels, pencils, eraser, old towel, fine  
mist spray bottle, old toothbrush
