Recommended Artist Quality Heavy Body Acrylic Paints: <u>Golden OPEN</u> is a "Slow-Dry" acrylic paint that is excellent if you want more blending time on the canvas! Traditional "Fast Dry" acrylic brands: <u>Utrecht Artist Acrylic Colors</u>, <u>Liquitex Professional Heavy Body Acrylic</u> <u>Paints</u>, or <u>Golden Artist Colors</u>. Please don't use student grade paints.

Palette: <u>12x16 Paper Palette Pad</u>. Or, if you don't like how fast acrylic paints dry on the palette a <u>Stay-Wet Palette System</u>: can help.

Spray Bottle: For misting the paints to prevent them drying too quickly.

Acrylic primed painting surfaces:

<u>Acrylic Primed Canvas Panels</u> or <u>Ampersand Gessobords</u> in a variety of sizes. 6x8 - 16x20. If you are new to painting I recommend working small (6x8 - 8x10) so that you can finish many quickly. The more paintings you paint, the quicker you will learn!

<u>Liquitex White Gesso</u> - Optional. Great for adding an extra coat to your canvas to prevent any adhesion surprises while painting. Also, you can white-out old paintings to paint new ones with this product.

Brushes: (Note: Have at least one 1" wide brush. <u>Liquitex "Freestyle</u>," <u>Silver "Bristlon</u>," <u>Princeton "Summit</u>," or <u>Robert Simmons "Titanium"</u> are all great brush brands.) Long Handle Flat Synthetic.Various sizes # 4, 6, 8, 10 & 12. Synthetic Liner - #0 "Simply Simmons" or similar.

Palette knife: diamond-shaped, 1.5" - 2" in length.

Brush washer: large empty yogurt container.

Paper Towels or Rags.
